Scholarship Amount:

- The Carole Ann Lee Aloha Scholarship is available to undergraduate students currently enrolled in the 2022-2023 academic year that will be returning in the 2023-2024 academic year.
- Applicant must aspire to be a force for positive change in their life, community, and the world.
- Although applicants from any background are welcome to apply, additional consideration will be given to students who identify with the Hawaiian Islands or Hawaiian Culture.
