

DIVERSITY, EQUITY, AND INCLUSION SCHOLARSHIP

About the Scholarship:

The Soka Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) Scholarship is designed to expand access to education for students from minoritized groups and/or students who exemplify a commitment to promoting diversity, equity, and inclusion in their community. Applicants of all backgrounds are eligible for consideration.

Scholarship Amount:

- The scholarship will be awarded to nine continuing undergraduates (three from each class) in the amount of \$3,500.
- The scholarship is awarded as a one-year award and is not automatically renewed.
- Eligible students are encouraged to apply each academic year.
- Recipients will be notified by the Office of Financial Aid within two months of the submission deadline.

Eligibility:

- The DEI Scholarship is available to undergraduate students who are currently enrolled in the 2023-2024 academic year.
- Students must identify with a minoritized group and/or exemplify a commitment to promoting diversity, equity, and inclusion at Soka University of America.
 - Examples may include but are not limited to those who identify with a racial or ethnic group, sexual orientation, gender identity, or other group that is minoritized.

Application Deadline:

• The deadline to submit your application to the Office of Financial Aid is October 2, 2023 by 5:00pm PST.
