About the Scholarship:

Southern California Edison is dedicated to recognizing students who want to be the “makers of tomorrow - the dreamers, inventors, guardians, and pioneers - those who dare to be great.” Southern California Edison has graciously funded a scholarship exclusive to Soka University of America students who have officially declared a qualifying Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) concentration. Students who have officially declared a concentration in Environmental Studies with the Office of the Registrar, and meet the scholarship’s requirements, are encouraged to apply.

Scholarship Amount:

- The Southern California Edison STEM Scholarship amount is up to a maximum of \$5,000 and will be awarded during the 2019-20 academic year.
- Multiple recipients will be selected.

Eligibility:

- The Southern California Edison STEM Scholarship is available to undergraduate students who have:
 - Officially declared Environmental Studies as their concentration with the Office of the Registrar.
 - Completed a minimum of two of the following 200, 300, and/or 400 level courses:
 - ECOL, EMP, ENVST, EOS, GEOG, ASTR, BIO, CHEM, Math, or PHYS
 - Demonstrated engagement in Environmental Studies-related activities such as: learning clusters, leadership positions, memberships, internships, volunteering, Capstone research, research assistantships, etc.

Application Deadline:

- The deadline to submit your application to the Office of Financial Aid is May 4, 2020 by 5:00pm.
